

OUR MISSION

Project Healing Waters Fly Fishing Canada provides a unique outlet for healing and rehabilitation to injured Canadians. Our efforts are targeted primarily at members of the Canadian Armed Forces who have been injured in combat but are open to all Canadians who may be suffering a wide range of physical and emotional trauma.

Because the work with clients is done on an outpatient basis, the program requires the support and energies of existing clubs, organizations and individuals in areas that have veterans or citizens who need what is offered through our program.

Our program provides basic fly fishing, fly casting and fly tying classes and clinics for the wounded and injured personnel ranging from beginners to

those with prior fly fishing and tying experience who are adapting their skills to their new abilities. Activities and services are provided to the participants at no cost. Fly fishing and tying equipment and materials are provided to the participants, including equipment that accommodates their special needs, as we are able to provide it.

Our training and educational activities are designed to ignite or rekindle the participants' appreciation and enthusiasm for a wide variety of fly fishing experiences and provide a healthy, safe opportunity to get outdoors and release stress or provide some relief from conditions like post traumatic stress disorder (PTSD).

Most fishing trips are conducted within a half-day's travel from hospitals, however we actively seek opportunities to offer quality fishing sites across the country and abroad.
